



### B Minor (2 Octaves)

Now we will extend the scale to include another octave. Remember, the distance between two B's is always thought of as octave (as in "8"- octagon, octopus etc) because if we play the scale- B C# D E F# G A we have 8 notes! But no matter how many notes we play though, the distance between one B and the next B is always thought of as an octave. And we call the distance between two notes an "interval".
